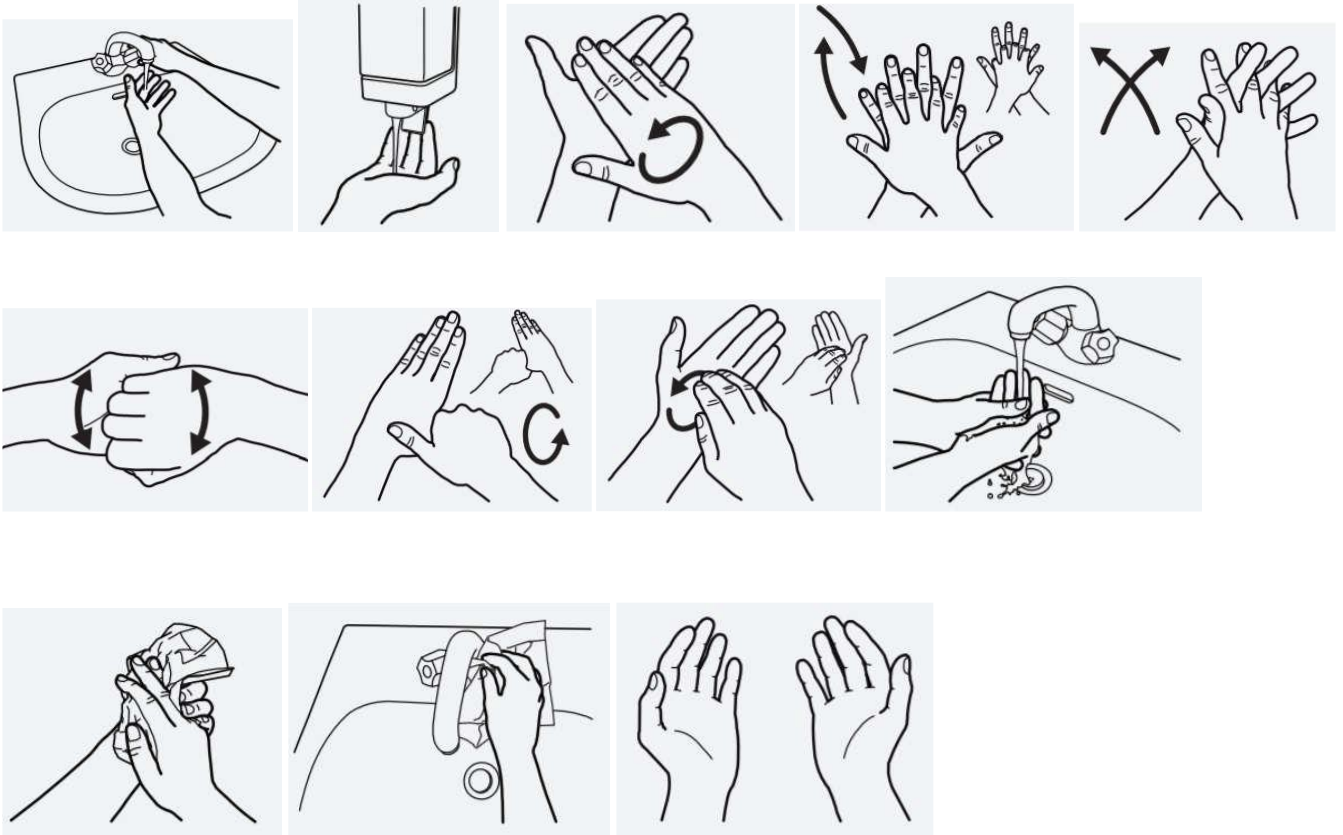


Using the dictionary

- k) Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces. ____
- l) Rub right palm over the left dorsum with interlaced fingers and vice versa. ____
